Checks tracks conditions			
Checks tracks for damage and abnormal play			
Checks coolant level

Check fuel tank and fuel level to ensure enough fuel for the trip			
Checks engine oil level

Check brake by pressing down on the brake pedal and making sure there is firm resistance, and the pedal fully returns to position when released

Checks rollover protection structure			
Checks hood latch to ensure it is secure			
Checks tailgate/cargo box is closed			
Checks accelerator pedal by pressing it a few times to ensure it operates freely and it returns to the rest position when released			
Applies brake holding mechanism and checks it operates properly			
Checks doors or cab net kit installment			
Checks seat belts for any damage. Fastens seat belts to confirm proper latch			
Avoids turning the wheel while vehicle is stopped			
Locates operator guide
