Main Entrance Gate  Exit Gate	<ul> <li>Animal attack</li> <li>Door remains open during business hours.</li> <li>Unauthorized persons/Vehicles can enter.</li> <li>Animal attack.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Security cameras</li> <li>After hours/weekends         <ul> <li>24hr security guard.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Employees to manually close/lock gate.</li> <li>Automated gate remains shut</li> </ul>
Shop bay doors/side doors	Unauthorized person/vehicles can enter if left unattended.	<ul> <li>during business hours.</li> <li>Security cameras.</li> <li>After hours/weekends 24hr security guard.</li> <li>Get out, hide out, take out.</li> <li>When possible, keep doors closed/locked.</li> </ul>
San Jose yard office	<ul> <li>Unauthorized persons can enter.</li> <li>Multiple entry/exit doors.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Security cameras.</li> <li>Keep closed/lock when not in use.</li> <li>Keep a clear path of exit (six entry/exit doors)</li> <li>In the event of an emergency outside the office, lock yourself in the conference room – use tables or chairs to help barricade/lock the doors.</li> </ul>
Customers/Visitors	<ul> <li>Disgruntled</li> <li>Physical altercation</li> <li>Verbal abuse</li> <li>Property damage</li> <li>Road rage</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Workplace Violence Incident Reporting App.</li> <li>Training employee on handling hostile employee's or situational awareness.</li> </ul>
Working Alone	<ul> <li>Unauthorized persons can enter.</li> <li>Employees can be trapped in the event of an attack.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Security cameras.</li> <li>If after hours a security guard is present.</li> <li>Can lock yourself in a safe space in the case of emergency.</li> </ul>
Working at night	<ul> <li>Unauthorized persons can enter.</li> <li>Unauthorized persons enter to access recycle dumpsters.</li> <li>Vandalism</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Security cameras.</li> <li>After hours/weekend 24rh security guard is present.</li> <li>Alarm systems.</li> <li>Yard has sufficient lighting.</li> </ul>
San Jose Northside fence (neighboring with the church)	<ul> <li>Unauthorized persons can enter.</li> <li>Poor lighting.</li> <li>Blind spots.</li> <li>Chain link fence (yard is visible, constant damage to fence to break in)</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Headlamps/flashlights</li> <li>Motion sensors</li> <li>Metal sheeting inserted into the fence.</li> </ul>
Securing Equipment/Vehicles	<ul> <li>Visible valuables.</li> <li>Unlocked vehicles.</li> <li>Unlocked tools and equipment on crew trucks</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Keep doors locked.</li> <li>Remove any valuable tools/belongings.</li> <li>Keep keys secured in shop office key lock box or with a hideaway magnet.</li> <li>Ensure all tools and equipment left</li> </ul>
